

TYPHOON MORAKOT FLOOD VICTIMS NEED YOUR HELP.....EDAC RESPONDS

On Aug. 8th 2009 Typhoon Morakot built in power and moved quickly west, the storm had passed over the Philippines, Taiwan and Mainland China, causing hundreds of millions of dollars in damage due to high winds, flooding and mudslides. Morakot broke many records in Taiwan, dumping a total of 2.6 meters (102 inches) of rain on the island. More than 300 people are known to have died so far, but hundreds remain missing and many from one village in Taiwan.
